Core to Alice's personal philosophy is the belief that we should tread more lightly upon the planet. Every purchase of Alice Stewart Jewellery is helping to restore one of the world's most precious woodland habitats - the beautiful Caledonian forest in the Scottish Highlands. Over the centuries, this magnificent forest - currently a vital home to several rare and endangered species has dramatically decreased due to deforestation and the over grazing of livestock.

For each bespoke piece of jewellery made, Trees For Life receive a charitable donation for planting trees, to help rebuild one of the world's most precious woodland habitats. This magical forest is an example of wilderness at its most wonderful, and needs our help to survive.

Designing your Bespoke Piece

To start the process Alice will go over initial design preferences with you via email to get a picture of the sort of style and design you're looking for. She will then go on to do some initial drawings around the design ideas discussed and give you a quote alongside images or videos of any gemstones you like the idea of using.

If you then decide to go ahead with one of the designs a deposit is taken for Alice to book in and start work on your chosen design. Payments can either be made in two or three instalments, depending on what works best for you, and are paid via bank transfer.

The design then starts life as a 3D model in either wax or silver which Alice will send over images or videos of for your feedback. At this point you will have the opportunity to make two rounds of alterations if needed, before your design is created in your chosen precious metal.

Once the piece is created in metal Alice will send over an update with a photo, and if any gemstones have been chosen for the design these are then set and the piece is hallmarked at the Birmingham Assay Office.

Final videos and photos are sent over to you before the final payment is settled and your bespoke piece is posted out insured and tracked via special delivery if being sent to the UK or DLH if outside of the UK.

FAQ's

HOW LONG DOES THE PROCESS TAKE?

Once the design has been decided on and the deposit paid the designing and creating of your piece can take up to 8 weeks. To keep the designing process moving forwards Alice asks for a response to requests for feedback within 3 days. If you've got a date in mind initially to have a piece ready for please let Alice know at the beginning of the process and she will work towards the date you have in mind.

WHERE ARE THE DIAMONDS & GEMSTONES FROM?

Alice only sources 100% natural untreated gemstones and diamonds from her reputable suppliers based in the Birmingham Jewellery Quarter. She has also built up a collection of unique vintage diamonds and gemstones over the years. Using these beautiful gemstones in new designs is one of the most sustainable and eco-friendly ways to incorporate natural gems into your one of a kind piece.

CAN I RESIZE A RING AFTER IT'S BEEN MADE?

Yes — most designs will allow for resizing by a size up or down, so small alterations at a later date are usually possible, but it's safest to get as close as possible to the right size initially. Alice can provide you with a printable ring sizer to get a good idea of the size you need.
